Introductory word

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



DEAR FRIENDS of UG Nešto Više.

The year behind us was one of the most challenging years for the Association. We encountered something we couldn't imagine, the COVID-19 pandemic. Like everyone we were surprised and shocked, but we realized that life must not stop, but we must adapt to the situation. Since the Association has existed, for 23 years, we have never been more exposed to something about which we had no experience or previous knowledge. We didn't know how to behave in a situation the whole world found itself in. We knew only one thing, we had to keep working, not as if it was a normal situation, but that what was normal would come back as soon as possible. Like many organizations, we "moved" to the virtual world, but we also had activities in the real world, as circumstances allowed, to provide the best possible service to those we work with the most for years: young people, women and people with disabilities.

We became the first organization in Bosnia and Herzegovina to have integrated permaculture principles in its Statute, Caring for People, Caring for the Earth, Fair Distribution of Goods, and all staff members earned a degree in permaculture designers.

The interhship program, or the program for gaining the first work experience, is the oldest program that the Association implements. This program has two segments, namely the segment for American students coming to Bosnia and Herzegovina and for BH students gaining experience in local companies,

organizations and institutions. This year, for the first time in 13 years, we did not have American students in our country, but we, together with our partners College of Saint Benedict & Saint John's University, immediately started preparations for 2021 and developed a project that will be implemented in 2022 and will be supported by the Fulbright-Hays Foundation.

The domestic internship was supported through two projects of the United States Embassy and through a project funded by the Delegation of the European Union to Bosnia and Herzegovina. Out of the total number of interns, over 50% managed to find additional engagement, during or immediately after the intership. We are especially proud because two people with disabilities, out of five in the EU project, managed to find a job.

We continued with the implementation of a project aimed at developing a gender action plan, and instead of in six local communities, we helped to create eight gender action plans. After the plans were completed, the Association awarded six donations to local communities to address some of the identified problems.

In addition to the "old" projects, we have launched a number of new ones. Our property in Mostar has become EcoHub, which operates in four municipalities: Konjic, Jablanica, Mostar and Trebinje, where we carry out activities related to environmental protection. As EkoHub Mostar, together with our partners, we

launched the action "I plant and you?", Which was supported by the Swedish government through the project "Think about nature" which is released by CPCD.

We have become a local structure, in Bosnia and Herzegovina, of the RISE program. RISE is implemented in six countries of the Western Balkans and a i m s to support social entrepreneurship, with a focus on young people.

Together with the Czech organization People in Need, as one of the local partners, we have developed and launched a project aimed at improving the employability of people with disabilities, especially people with intellectual disabilities.

At the end of the year, we signed two large contracts with the Delegation of the European Union for projects that we will implement in the next three years.

The year was strange, we didn't move but thanks to technology we were "everywhere", we started a lot of new things, we finished some, we are still thinking about some, but most importantly we managed to save the health of our loved ones, the health of those because which we do all this and our health, which is certainly the greatest success in a year that has shown us that everything can be different.

Geographical presence

The Association of Citizens "Something More" has three official offices: Central Office Sarajevo, Regional Office Mostar and Regional Office East New Sarajevo. The staff of the Association works and lives in four cities of Bosnia and Herzegovina: Sarajevo, Banja Luka, Mostar and East Sarajevo. The Mostar office of the Association is located on the farm of the Association in Humilišani, where all the necessary conditions for the work of the staff have been created - one building on the property has been renovated so that there are offices, classrooms and a conference hall in the building. In order to ensure sustainability, the Association has established its own social enterprise EkoDizajn d.o.o. which deals with the production of organic seedlings, arranging yards and orchards according to permaculture principles and organizing events, trainings. UG Nešto Više operates throughout Bosnia and Herzegovina, so that in the last 23 years we have implemented projects in over 70 different local communities in BiH and over a hundred volunteer actions in the same number of communities.



Improvement of social services through strengthening of NGO in BH



The project "Improvement of social services through strengthening NGOs in BiH", funded by the Czech Development Cooperation and implemented by CARE International in BiH, has enabled us to raise the support of our users to a higher level.

We have improved the infrastructure of the Association, the property and the facility we own in Mostar have been fully trained for the work and accommodation of our users: We have installed a facade on the house, fences on terraces and stairs, we have equipped 2 rooms to accommodate 8 people property maintenance tools: (mowers,, trimmer), irrigation and work equipment (laptop, printer).

In addition, we have developed a set of new services for users: occupational therapies and education in the field of permaculture, renewable energy, energy efficiency and the green economy.

In line with the new situation related to the COVID-19 virus pandemic, we have developed a set of online trainings for our users, who can engage in "urban" agriculture by following our online trainings, "Edible Garden" and the Small School of Fruit Growing, vegetables, herbs, herbs and flowers.

More than 500 beneficiaries from Bosnia and Herzegovina participated in the project activities.

Strengthening leadership skills of girls and women with focus in Mostar region



At the beginning of the month of September 2019 we started with the implementation of another interesting and useful project titled "Strengthening leadership skills of girls and women with focus in Mostar region".

The project is devised with the aim to strengthen the role of women in our society, that together with them we are working on strengthening their self-confidence and leadership skills on how they could be the starters of a better and healthier life in BiH.

The project is supported by the "Canada Fund for Local Initiatives (CFLI)." During the realization of this project, we directly worked with over 60 girls and women in strengthening their leadership skills, on their self-evaluation, on strengthening their self-esteem and on giving them guidelines for the best ways to implement business and other socially useful ideas.

In addition, we established cooperation with secondary schools where we hold lectures about leadership skills. In that way we introduced young persons with all the advantages and opportunities that leadership carries with it.

Green business for healthy environment in BiH



The general goal of the project is to improve the cooperation of organizations dealing with green economy, social entrepreneurship and environmental protection through networking of CSOs dealing with green economy and social entrepreneurship, institutions and media to work together to promote green entrepreneurship.

We held two round tables on the topic:

Creating green jobs through sustainable development of companies and cooperatives (economic, social and environmental sustainability; people employed directly or indirectly in the green economy)

We also had two educational / practical sessions: Practical use of clean energy sources, thermal solar and photo solar clean energy sources in everyday life, on farms and at work.

The workshops were attended by a large number of activists from various organizations who had the opportunity to get acquainted with all the environmental elements that we have implemented on our property.

We also did a media campaign promoting green jobs.

A total of 73 people participated in our activities.

Support to Gender Action Plan Development in Six Local Communities in BH



This project aims to increase and sufficiently strengthen the capacities of local CSOs, public and private sector in six local communities – Banovići, Cazin, Han Pijesak, Rogatica, Teslić and Živinice - in order to effectively lead the process of the improvement of current position of women, therefore enabling their uninterrupted and easy access to local resources, information, infrastructure, and active participation in social and political life in form of supporting Gender Action Plans development.

Overall objective is to support systematic structural changes in BH society that will lead to gender equality on local and national level with project goal being to strengthen the role women in society and support to local partnerships in establishing effective mechanisms for gender equality in six selected communities in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

The Eco HUB Mostar Resource Centre for Environmental Issues



The Project is being implemented in four municipalities / cities: Mostar, Trebinje, Konjic and Jablanica.

The project is being realized within the larger project "Think Nature!".

The goal of Eco HUB is to contribute to the preservation and regeneration of the environment in Herzegovina through the establishment and operation of Eco HUB Mostar and by providing support to local communities in preserving the environment.

The establishment of Eco HUB Mostar creates the necessary preconditions for supporting local communities in the development and implementation of projects and actions in the field of environmental protection, and making available the permaculture farm Nešto Više and a place where people can see practical solutions in this area, such as solar panels, water purification, rainwater collection, etc.

"Think Nature!" Is a three-year project implemented by the Center for the Promotion of Civil Society, and financially supported by Sweden in the amount of 3 million convertible marks.

The complexity of environmental issues requires a continuous presence at the local level, expertise in the field of environmental protection, networking with local actors, the ability to communicate with youth, schools and media, and the capacity to provide educational and professional support to other organizations and schools, and that will be provided throug Eco Hub.

Practical Working Experience for Youth and Youth with Disabilities



The project is implemented in the framework of the Fund for economic support.

The project aims to strengthen and update training theoretical knowledge of young people and persons with disabilities (from 18 to 30 years of age) without prior work experience, in the profession for which they acquired title, through practical work experience to increase their enhancing employability and strengthening their position on the labour market.

48 people got a chance to acquire or improve certain skills related to the preparation for the interview, and to work for 2 months in one of the companies in BiH, gained practical experience and got paid for their work.

First Practical Work Experience for Women with University degree



The project aims to contribute to faster and easier employment of highly educated girls / women who have no work experience.

Through the project, we will provide a two-month paid internship for 38 young women in their final years of study or with a university degree without work experience.

With this project, we continue to provide opportunities for young women (from 20 to 30 years old) to gain their first practical work experience lasting 2 months (320 working hours) in one of the companies in BiH from their field of interest and studies.

In addition to practical experience, all participants will receive training in CV writing and training on proper performance at a job interview.

The staff of UG Nešto Više will provide support to the participants in the process of finding a suitable company in which they will be able to gain their first work experience.



Community of Different but Equal Citizens



The project "Communities of different but equal citizens" aims to achieve a higher level of involvement of civil society organizations in the process of European integration, focusing on increasing social inclusion and non-discrimination of persons with disabilities.

The project will contribute to the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals 2030. The organization "UDAS" is implementing the project in partnership with the Helsinki Citizens' Parliament Banja Luka and the Association of Citizens "Nesto Više" Sarajevo.

The realization of the project aims to strengthen the capacities of the network of women with disabilities and the network of persons with disabilities UDAS.

In addition, the aim is to increase the social sensitivity of civil society organizations, which are not primarily organizations of persons with disabilities, as well as representatives of local authorities.

Work has also been done to increase promotional activities and public advocacy for the integration of persons with disabilities, through various activities of civil society organizations, media, government and the public, which will eventually result in the inclusion of persons with disabilities in decision-making processes.

Improving the advocacy skills of PWDs and the sustainability of organizations of persons with disabilities



The project aims to make an analysis of the current state of human resources and the online presence of organizations of persons with disabilities that will serve as a basis for other activities.

Activities are trainings for staff of organizations of persons with disabilities and their users with the aim of improving advocacy skills, increasing online presence in our and English, using tools for promotion and networking, data exchange and raising funds for greater self-sustainability.

For the needs of media promotion, an educational video was recorded and online promo materials were made in order to bring people with disabilities and people without disabilities closer to each other.

The project includes 6 organizations of persons with disabilities from FBiH.





Development of Training Program for Members of Municipal Gender Equality Commissions in Bosnia and Herzegovina





To develop a model for enhancing gender equality on local level communities which can be replicated in other BH local communities.






